Entertainment Rules and Regulations

Fees

Entertainers are responsible for the timely submission of application fees. The application fee is non-refundable. **Choochokam Arts does not charge a commission on items sold by performers.**

SSN or EIN Number

Performers will not be paid without submission of EIN or SSN number.

Performance Assignments

Performance assignments are at the sole discretion of Choochokam Arts staff and are not interchangeable. While Choochokam Arts attempts to honor specific performance date/time requests, no guarantees can be made. Performance/stage assignments are made to create an appealing mix of entertainment, considering the character of the work to be performed.

Weather Preparation

The weather in Langley during the summer months can be unpredictable. Each performer is expected to come prepared for inclement conditions including rain and wind. This includes appropriate covers for yourself and your equipment.

Stage Load-In / Load-Out

Entertainers will abide by loading, unloading and parking procedures as prescribed by Choochokam Arts, the Langley Police Department, South Whidbey Fire District and the City of Langley. The entertainer must agree to set up his/her equipment within established stage boundaries and timeframe.

Performance Criteria

Entertainers may only perform original works in the genre approved by the jury. Entertainment performed must be comparable in style and quality to the work presented in the application accepted by the jury. Compliance will be verified during the festival. Participants must comply with the selection criteria as described in the *Entertainment Application Form* and the *Letter of Acceptance*. Choochokam Arts reserves the right to deny the performance of any works that do not meet the standards set forth in the *Entertainment Application* and these *Rules and Regulations*.

It is understood that Choochokam Arts is a nonprofit 501 (c)(4) organization. As a performer you must agree to hold harmless its officers, directors, employees and agents from and against any and all liability which may arise by reason of the participant being given the right to be in the show and which may arise out of acts and/or negligence of the participant or the participant's employees or other persons acting on the behalf of the participants.

The exhibitor releases Choochokam Arts and all of its duly appointed representatives of all liability and responsibility for any injury, damage or loss sustained by entertainers, exhibitors, or guests, during or after the Choochokam Arts Festival or as a result of the exhibition of work, equipment or materials.

Choochokam Arts reserves the right to revise these regulations and/or terminate this agreement at its sole discretion.
